Be Prepared:

Have a Winter Emergency Kit in your vehicle

- ❖ Windshield scraper and snow brush
- ❖ Blankets or Sleeping Bag, Extra Hats, Mittens, Sweaters...
- ❖ Flashlight, Candles
- ❖ Food (Granola Bars, Candy, Canned Nuts, Raisins) and Water
- ❖ Emergency Number, Money Stash
- ❖ First Aid Kit
- ❖ Bag of Sand, Jumper Cables, Towing Chains

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- ❖ Keep plenty of gas (at least half a tank) and windshield washer fluid in your vehicle.
- ❖ Make sure your heater, defroster and rear defogger are working properly.
- ❖ Have your tires checked and make sure your spare tire has air in it.



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- ❖ Know your brakes: Anti-Lock = Don't Pump the Brakes
 Regular = Pump the Brakes
- ❖ Leave Plenty of room between your car and others on the road
