- » **Circles of Support:** A community engagement program designed to erase the impact of isolation that accompanies poverty

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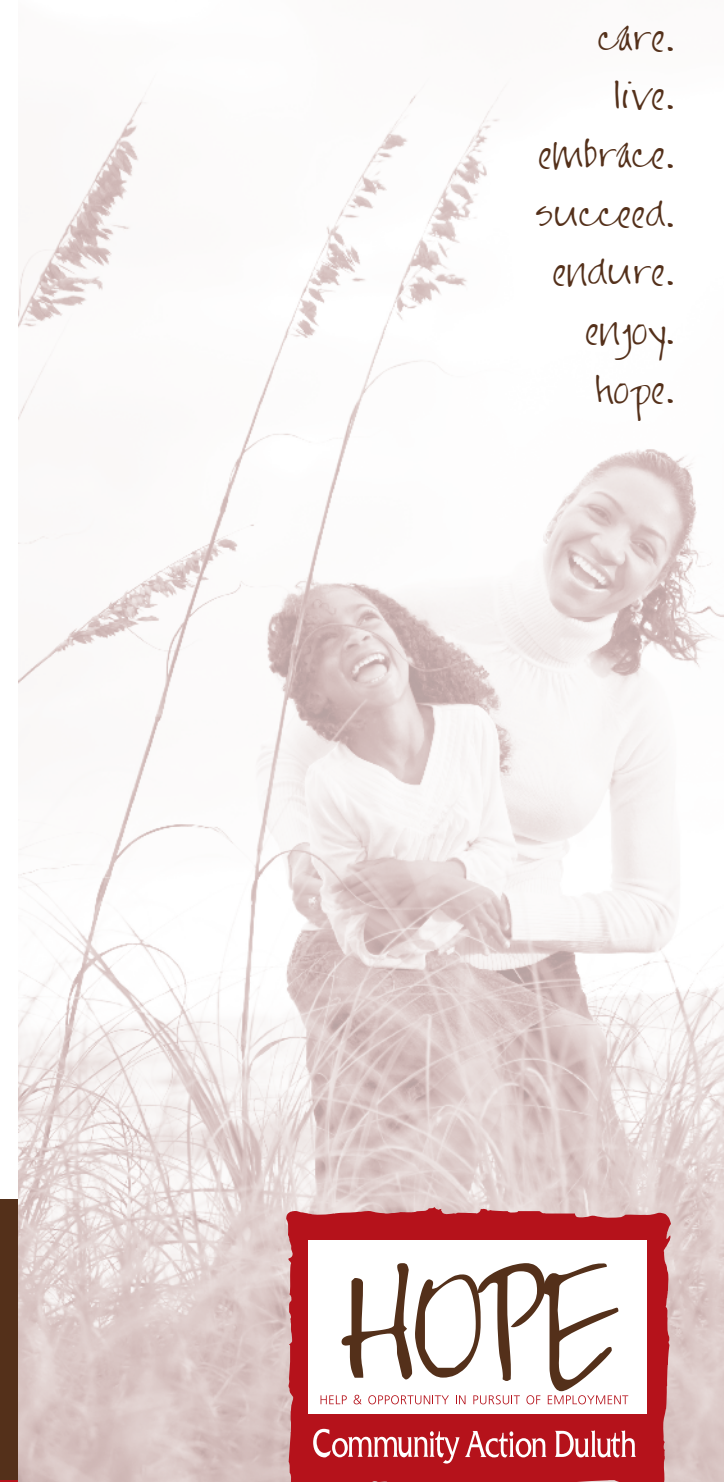
